
Forest Bathing

Studies have found that forest bathing has positive physiological effects, such as blood pressure reduction, improvement of autonomic and immune functions, and the psychological effects of alleviating depression and improving mental health. Studies have shown these effects on people of working age with and without depressive tendencies.
