Gonzalo Ortiz will share his expertise in starting and managing a young vineyard in this outdoor workshop. The main focus will be dormant season vineyard management of young grape vines for small-sized vineyards, emphasizing winter vineyard management of young vines in their first and second winters. He will explain how to set up a VSP trellis and explore alternatives. He will also share pruning considerations for young grapevines while establishing permanent structures. Lastly, he will discuss considerations and options for managing pruning material. **Remember this is an all-outdoor activity: dress accordingly with proper footwear and layer for potential cooler temperatures. Restrooms will not be available.**
